



Exhibiting Art at Three Rivers Market

To Apply

Artists interested in showing work at Three Rivers Market should email 5-10 jpegs of art work and a brief artist statement to Katie Ries (k.ries@threeriversmarket.coop) before March 1st or Sept 1st. Images should accurately represent the work to be shown. Submitted work will be reviewed twice a year in early March and early September. We will be in touch with artists by the end of those months.

Three Rivers Market (TRM) is a community grocery store with a broad and varied customer base. As such, any potentially offensive work will not be accepted. We reserve the right to edit work once it has been installed. If you have any questions about whether or not something is appropriate, please feel free to ask.

If your work is accepted you must provide a \$50 cash or check deposit which will be returned to you after you have uninstalled your show, patched, sanded, and repainted the walls on the scheduled dates. TRM will provide materials to repair and repaint the wall.

The Basics

All work must be ready to hang in drywall with metal studs. All hanging hardware and tools must be supplied by the artist (with the exception of materials needed to return the walls to their original condition). Work does not need to be framed but must be hung securely. Large pieces must be well supported. Plan to display a typed sheet with your name, contact information, and an artist statement.

Art may be displayed on the largest wall in the TRM dining area and the facing wall (above our counter). The wall is drywall and metal studs. The large wall exhibition area is approximately 9' x 8'. The smaller facing wall is approximately 9' x 4'.

Art installation will be Tuesday evening, from 8-10 pm before the first Friday of the month. Uninstallation will be on the Monday from 8 am - 10 am before the next first Friday. Please be in touch immediately if those dates and times will not work for you. If you reschedule your installation or uninstallation with less than two weeks notice we will keep your deposit.

TRM will make every effort to see that the work is not damaged, but is ultimately not responsible for any damage or theft of work. Artists wishing to insure their work are encouraged to do so.

If the work is for sale, the artist must provide clear contact information next to or in the exhibit. Any sales must be handled by the artist. TRM cannot assist in the sale. All proceeds go to the artist. There is no commission.
