The Meat Stocker-Receiver reports to the Meat Department Manager. The work includes cutting, grinding and packaging products as well as merchandising, cleaning, and responding to customer requests and needs.

This is a part-time, non-exempt, 20-25 hours per week position.

Pay is negotiable and dependent upon experience, education, and the capacity and creativity to help us grow the department. Our minimum wage is currently \$10.75/hour after a 90 Day Trial Period.

Women, members of ethnic minorities, and/or persons age 40 and over are strongly encouraged to apply.

- Available to work early mornings and weekends. Shifts are typically 7 am – 3 pm or 11 am – 6 pm. Quarterly inventory count shifts are possible.
