  - Even if you test negative, stay home for the full 7 days.
  - If your test is positive or you have symptoms of COVID-19, <u>isolate</u> yourself to protect others from getting infected and follow public health recommendations.
- If you don't get tested, it's safest to stay home for 10 days after travel.
- Avoid being around people who are at <u>increased risk for severe illness</u> for 14 days, whether you get tested or not.
- Always follow <u>state and local</u> recommendations or requirements related to travel.
